Physically capable of lifting and transferring to assist with restroom use, personal care and physical intervention when necessary to meet the person's needs. This position requires medium work as defined in the Dictionary of Occupational Titles: exerting 20-50 pounds of force occasionally and 10-25 pounds frequently. Must possess an acceptable driving record and be willing to participate in random drug screening as required. **Within this position you also will be required to work some evening and weekend hours and provide Community Living Support Services (CLS).
