The position requires medium work as defined in the Dictionary of Occupational Titles: exerting 20-50 pounds of force occasionally and 10-25 pounds frequently.

Driving is required for this position; therefore, eligible candidates must possess a valid driver's license, have an acceptable driving record as well as a reliable vehicle, be able to obtain and maintain agency insurance requirements, as well as obtain a chauffeur's license.
