MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Six months volunteer, personal or work experience relevant to the job assignment. Able to communicate effectively in writing and speech, and to complete necessary reports. Able to read and comprehend programs for persons served. Physically capable of providing assistance to persons served with lifting and transferring, and personal care when necessary.

Driving is required for this position, therefore eligible candidates must possess a valid driver's license, have an acceptable driving record as well as a reliable vehicle, be able to obtain and maintain agency insurance requirements, as well as obtain a chauffeur's license.

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS: Experience in an employment training program or other community-based rehabilitation program. Completion of training relevant to position i.e., First Aid, CPR, Gentle Teaching, Mental Health First Aid, and Sign Language.
